A scholarship scheme for the students belonging to notified minority communities (Buddhist, Christian, Jain, Muslim, Parsi and Sikh) of West Bengal.

**Online Application starts on 15-07-2024**

## Criteria for application

- Students intending to apply must be domicile of West Bengal
- Students studying in schools must have the unique ID of "Banglar Siksha"
- Securing 50% marks in previous examination (except for Pre-Matric, Class-I and TSP candidates)
- Students must have bank accounts of their own
- In case of the students under the category of Pre-Matric, bank account either of their parents must be provided
- Annual income ceiling of the family for various scholarships:
  - Pre-Matric** — Rupees 2 lakh
  - Post- Matric** — Rupees 2 lakh
  - Merit-cum-Means** — Rupees 2.5 lakh
  - TSP** — Rupees 2 lakh
  - SVMCM** — Rupees 2.5 lakh

## New features of the Scheme

- Students studying in classes II to X and XII, who had applied for Aikyashree Scholarship during the academic year 2023-24, need not apply afresh for renewal.
- Students eligible for renewal will receive confirmation through SMS.
- Only students of pre-matric category who have taken admission in class one or in a new school should apply online. Students who will take admission in class XI also need to apply online.
